ALICE Transportation Project

Bus Passes may be issued to <u>working class citizens</u> living in the Greater Battle Creek area, that are at or below the 80% Median Family Income for Calhoun County.

Required documentation:

- Completed NIBC registration form (front desk)
- ID
- Proof of employment (One month of recent check stubs.)

Additional information:

- The number of passes issued will cover two weeks of round-trip transportation for a five-day work week.
- Individuals will need to come in on a bi-weekly basis with their ID to receive additional passes.
- Other working family members will need to also come in and register to receive passes.
